A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE ENLARGEMENT OF THE
NORTH ROSE FIRE DISTRICT OF THE TOWN OF ROSE IN
THE COUNTY OF WAYNE, NEW YORK.

WHEREAS, a petition for the enlargement of the
NORTH ROSE FIRE DISTRICT was presented to a joint meeting
of the Town Boards of the Towns of Rose and Huron held on
the 8th day of June, 1937, by F. J. Tague and others, and

WHEREAS, the said Town Boards, desiring to grant
a public hearing before taking any action with respect there-
to, did, on the 8th day of June, 1937, order that a hearing
on said petition be held on the 30th day of June, 1937, at
eight o'clock P.M., at the residence of H. B. Thomas in
said Town of Huron, and did direct that a notice of such
hearing be published and posted in the manner required by
law, and

WHEREAS, the said notice was published on the 17th
day of June, 1937, in The Lake Shore News, a newspaper pub-
lished in the Village of Wolcott, Wayne County, New York,
and having a general circulation in said district and territory
included within the proposed extension of said North Rose Fire
District, and was posted in not less than five public places
in the territory included within the proposed extension of
said Fire District, and

WHEREAS, the Town Boards of the Towns of Rose and
Huron at a joint meeting thereof have determined that said
petition is in fact signed and acknowledged and proved in
the same manner as a deed to be recorded and complies with
the provisions of Section 171 of the Town Law of this State,
and the said Town Boards at a joint meeting thereof have duly
held a hearing on said petition at the time and place described
in said notice and at said hearing have heard all persons
owning taxable real property in said district or in said

territory and all other persons desiring to be heard with respect to matters affecting their property or the benefits resulting from the enlargement of said District, and as to whether it is in the public interest to grant said petition in whole or in part, and as to whether all property owners and interested persons within said district or said territory are benefited thereby, and as to whether all property or property owners benefited are included therein: NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED, that it be and hereby is determined that it is in the public interest to grant in whole the relief sought in said petition; that the property owners and interested persons within the territory proposed to be added to said Fire District by said enlargement are benefited thereby; that all property or property owners benefited are included in said territory.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that said NORTH ROSE FIRE DISTRICT be, and the same hereby, is extended and enlarged so that it will take in and include the outside real property comprising the territory bounded and described as follows:

ALL THAT TRACT OR PARCEL OF LAND, situate partly in the Town of Rose and partly in the Town of Huron, in the County of Wayne, State of New York, bounded and described as follows: Beginning at a point in the east line of the Town of Rose at the north-east corner of Fire District No. 1 of the Town of Rose, thence north along the east line of the Town of Rose to the north-east corner of said Town of Rose; thence west along the north line of the Town of Rose to a point twenty (20) rods easterly from the center of the highway leading from Lovejoy's corners to the Graham School house corners; thence northerly on a line parallel with said last mentioned highway and twenty (20) rods distant easterly therefrom to the center of the first highway leading from the Village of Wolcott to the Fifth Road. Thence north twenty (20) rods; thence westerly on a line parallel with center line of the last mentioned highway to a point twenty (20) rods easterly from the

center line of the highway leading from Fleeks corners to the Ridge Road. Thence northerly on a line parallel with said last mentioned highway and twenty (20) rods distant easterly therefrom to the center line of the Ridge Road. Thence north twenty (20) rods; thence westerly on a line parallel with the center line of said Ridge Road to a point twenty (20) rods easterly from the center line of the highway leading from Sherman's corners north. Thence north on a line parallel with said last mentioned highway and twenty (20) rods distant easterly therefrom to the end of said highway and continuing said line north in a straight line to Lake Ontario.

Thence westerly following the shore line of Lake Ontario and the top of the high bank west of Lake Bluff to east shore of Sodus Bay; thence in a straight line to the northern most point of LeRoy's Island; thence southerly along the west shore of LeRoy's Island to its southern most point; thence easterly to the east shore of Sodus Bay; thence southerly along the east shore of Sodus Bay to a point twenty (20) rods north of the Ridge Road; thence west on a line parallel with the center line of Ridge Road and twenty (20) rods northerly therefrom to a point twenty (20) rods west of the center line of the highway running north and south at the Brick School house corner; thence southerly on a line parallel with said last mentioned highway and twenty (20) rods distant westerly therefrom to the north line of the Town of Rose; thence westerly along said north line of the Town of Rose to the north-west corner of the Town of Rose; thence southerly along the west line of the Town of Rose to the north-west corner of said Fire District No. 1 of the Town of Rose; thence easterly along said Fire District line to the place of beginning.
