

**BOUNDARIES OF NORTH ROSE FIRE DISTRICT
AS ESTABLISHED BY LAW, APRIL 17th, 1911.**

Beginning in the center of Main Street in North Rose, said point being at the southern boundary line of the Addison Dagle Farm, thence easterly along the south boundary line of said Dagle Farm to the south east corner thereof; thence northerly along east line of said Dagle Farm and continuing in a straight line across Rome Watertown and Ogdensburg Railroad to the north line thereof; thence easterly to the most southern point on the boundary line between the lands of Henry A. Lamb and Peter Salter; thence northerly along the boundary line of said farms to the Center of the highway known as Wolcott or Graham Street; thence easterly along the center of the said highway to the eastern lines of the land of Warren W. Morey; thence northerly along said Morey's east line 34 rods and 15 feet; thence westerly parallel with Morey's east line 34 rods and 15 feet; thence westerly parallel with Graham Street across the lands of J.C. Aldrich, Geo. W. Aldrich, the Fifth Road, lands of Ann Proseus, to the center of Proseus Creek, thence following the center on the said creek southerly across the lands of Ann Proseus, Geo W. Aldrich, RW & ORR, the farm of Addison Dagle, to the north line of the lands of John J. Miner; thence easterly along the north line of the said John J. Miner's farm to the place of beginning.

**BOUNDARIES OF NORTH ROSE-HURON FIRE DISTRICT
AS ENLARGED BY JOINT MEETING OF TOWN BOARDS OF
ROSE AND HURON JUNE 30th, 1937.**

All that Tract or Parcel of Land, situate partly in the Town of Rose partly in the Town of Huron in the County of Wayne and State of New York, bounded and described as follows: Beginning at a point in the east line of the Town of Rose at the northeast corner of Fire District No. 1 of the Town of Rose, thence along the east line of the Town of Rose to the northeast corner of said Town, thence west along the north line of the Town of Rose to a point 20 rods easterly from the center of the highway leading from Lovejoy's corners to the Graham School house corners; thence northerly on a line parallel with said last mentioned highway and 20 rods distant easterly therefrom to the center of the first highway leading from the Village of Wolcott to the Fifth Road, thence north 20 rods; thence westerly on a line parallel with center line of the last mentioned highway to a point 20 rods easterly from the center line of the highway leading from Fleeks corners to the Ridge Road. Thence northerly on a line parallel with said last mentioned highway and 20 rods distant easterly therefrom to the center line of the Ridge Road. Thence north 20 rods; thence westerly on a line parallel with the center line of said Ridge Road to a point 20 rods easterly from the center line of the highway leading from Sherman's corners north. Thence north on a line parallel with said last mentioned highway and 20 rods distant easterly therefrom to the end of said highway and continuing said line north in a straight line to Lake Ontario. THENCE westerly following the shore line of Lake Ontario and the top of the high bank west of Lake Bluff to the east shore of Sodus Bay; thence in a straight line to the northern most point of LeRoy's Island; thence southerly along the west shore of LeRoy's Island to it's southern most point.

the center on the said creek southerly across the lands of Ann Proseus, Geo W. Aldrich, RW & ORR, the farm of Addison Dagle, to the north line of the lands of John J. Miner; thence easterly along the north line of the said John J. Miner's farm to the place of beginning.

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thence easterly to the east shore of Sodus Bay to a point 20 rods north of the Ridge Road; thence west on a line parallel with the center line of Ridge Road and 20 rods northerly thereof to a point 20 rods west of the center line of the highway running north and south at the Brick Schoolhouse corner; thence southerly on a line parallel with said last mentioned highway and 20 rods distant westerly therefrom to the north line of the Town of Rose; thence westerly along said north line to the northwest corner of the Town of Rose; thence southerly along the west line of the Town of Rose to the northwest corner of Fire District No. 1 of Town of Rose thence easterly to the place of beginning.
